



## San Juan La Laguna, Solola, Guatemala November 27 – December 10, 2010 “Delivering Health and Hope to the World”

### ABOUT GUATEMALA

Two mountain chains from west to east divide the country into three regions: the highlands; the Pacific coast, south of the mountain; and the region north of the mountains. All major cities are located in the highlands and Pacific coast regions. The country has 14 eco-regions ranging from Mangrove forests to ocean littorals with five different eco systems overall. There is an approximate population of 14 million in an area of roughly 110,000 square kilometers.

### ABOUT THE CLINIC SITE

Clinica San Juanerita is located in San Juan La Laguna, Solola District. There is one doctor who visits the clinic twice each month and a nurse practitioner on duty five half days each week. The local sponsors request that the team work side by side with the local doctor and nurse practitioner and provide health instruction to the community. The team will also travel across Lake Atitlan to El Hospitalito in Santiago for several days to provide general patient care.



### WE NEED YOU!

The people of San Juan La Laguna need your help! Experienced family practice doctors, dentists, and nurses are requested. Prominent diseases and areas of treatment include gastrointestinal, fungal infections, respiratory, hypertension, and gynecology.

The cost for this trip is \$2,000 including airfare, accommodations, in-country transportation and meals. The work at the clinic can be followed by a short leisure trip around Santiago touring various markets, coffee farms, and nature preserves, and a drive to Antigua, a quaint Spanish city that has been preserved in its original form.
